The banner points across the top of the table refer to the market segments that discussed in the table

- Universe – Total Installed PCs in the US.
- Home/Family PCs - includes the primary PC purchased or acquired by household members, excluding those that are used for self-employment or those that may be in the household but are owned by an employer. This segment currently represents 80.5 million PCs.
- Self-Employed PCs – the primary PC that is acquired by household members in a business they own (i.e., a sole proprietorship). Proprietorships may be run from a home or from an office. Thus, Self-Employed PCs may be located in either place. This segment currently represents 12.7 million PCs.
- Workplace PCs – the primary personal computer acquired by employers and provided to their employees for use at the workplace, at home or in other locations. This segment currently represents 54.4 million PCs.
